However, when it was a topic that he wasn't explaining as well to begin with, I would for example ask him a question and he would kind of just float around it and not quite answer it as effectively as other topics and when this would happen, I wouldn't feel like my question was answered and I wouldn't feel like he helped me almost at all in those situations. He's not a bad teacher, I just think that he should be more consistent and should work on teaching and explaining those topics that he doesn't do the best of a job on. Overall, I give him a strong 6 or a light 7 out of 10.
